Recycling saves energy and natural resources, creates jobs, and saves landfill space. Residents of Pasco can take their recyclable items to one of several recycling drop boxes; please refer to the map on the back of this page for drop box locations.

## What can be recycled?

Drop box locations throughout Pasco accept:

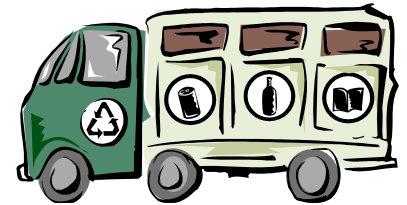
Newspaper – *everything in the newspaper is recyclable, even the advertisements.*

Brown and Clear Glass – *rinse and separate. The labels do not need to be removed.*

Mixed Paper – *includes all office paper and mail.*

Aluminum and Tin cans – *rinsed and crushed if possible.*

Corrugated Cardboard – *please flatten all boxes before recycling.*

## Have Hazardous Waste?

Franklin County residents may recycle household hazardous waste for free at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located off the Kahlotus Highway. Before you arrive, please call (509) 547-6666 to make an appointment. No commercial establishments or commercially generated waste is accepted.

### Acceptable:

- Tires
- Car Batteries
- Antifreeze
- Appliances (Freon and non-Freon)
- Chemicals, Cleaners, and Aerosols
- Oil-based Paints and Solvents
- Pesticides and Herbicides

### Does Not Accept:

- Explosives
- Asbestos
- Industrial Waste
- Agricultural Waste
- Radioactive Materials
- Ammunition
- Medical Waste
- Commercial Waste
