

Kennewick's Recycling Program



Who can recycle?

Everybody! Residents living inside Kennewick's city limits can recycle at the curb and all others can recycle at collection containers scattered throughout the City; or to businesses like Clayton Ward Recycling or Pacific Recycling.

What can be recycled at the curb?

Aluminum, tin and plastic containers with a narrow neck, #1 through #7 can be recycled together (co-mingled) in Waste Management provided bins. Bundled newspaper, bagged scrap paper, flattened cardboard and used motor oil can also be recycled at the curb. Oil must be in a container with a tight fitting lid and labeled. Recycled materials should be placed at the curb on the same day as garbage pick-up. For more information, call Waste Management, 582-5121.

What can be recycled at drop boxes?

Glass Jars and Bottles: Rinse and separate clear, brown and green. Labels do not have to be removed. PLEASE no light bulbs, Pyrex, drinking glasses or window glass.



Tin and Aluminum: Rinse and flatten if possible. Rinse aluminum foil. Lids from jars are o.k. as are gum and mint tins. No scrap metal allowed.



Cardboard: Only flattened and bundled corrugated cardboard.



Newspapers/Magazines: Everything in the daily newspaper is recyclable.



Plastics: Rinse and flatten plastic containers marked with #1 through #7.

- ◆ West of Albertson's on Keene, behind strip mall in South Richland
- ◆ Wal-Mart Parking lot on Duportail in South Richland
- ◆ Near Fire Station - Rancho Reata and Bermuda Road
